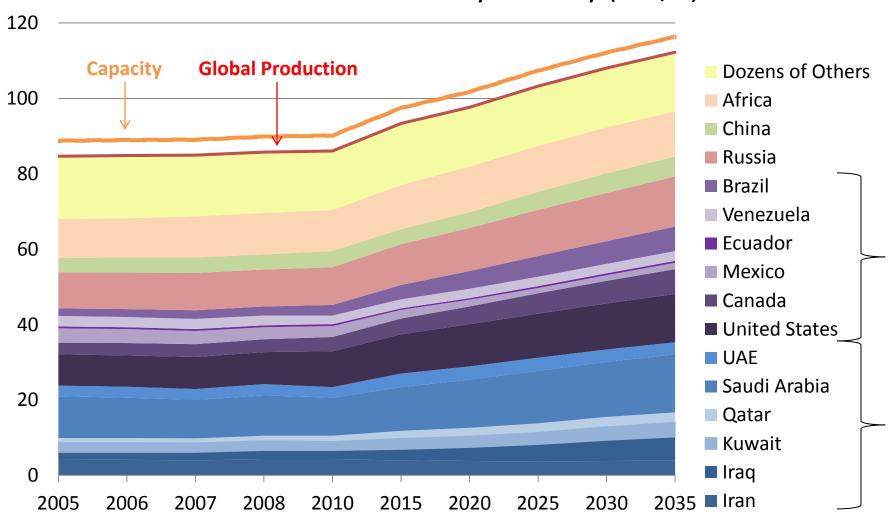

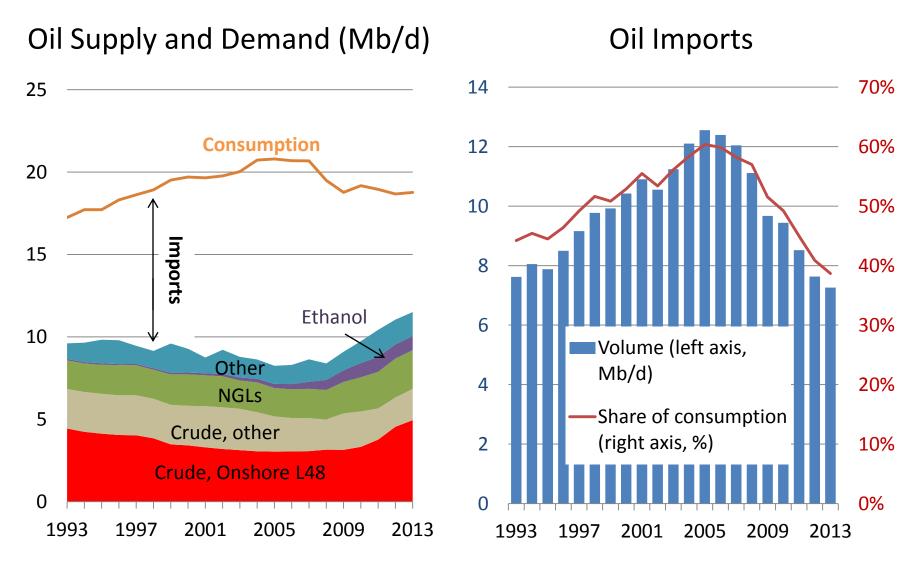
## Challenges to Oil Market Stability

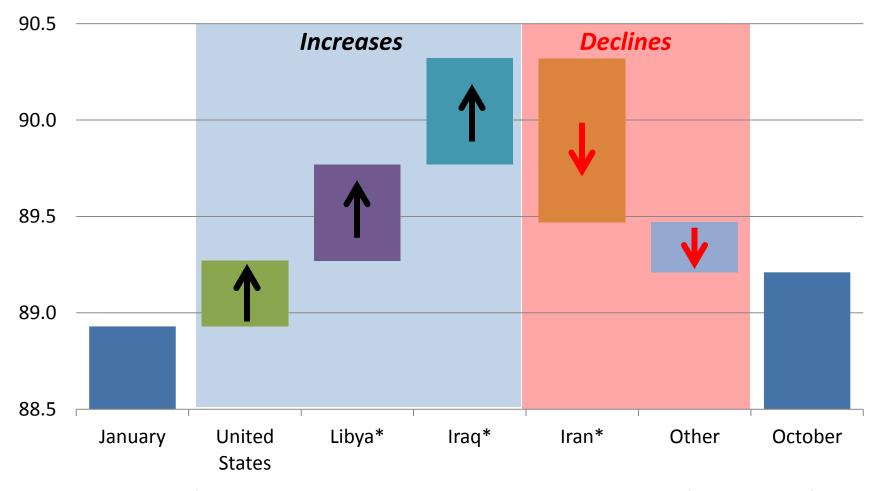
#### U.S. Oil Import Dependence

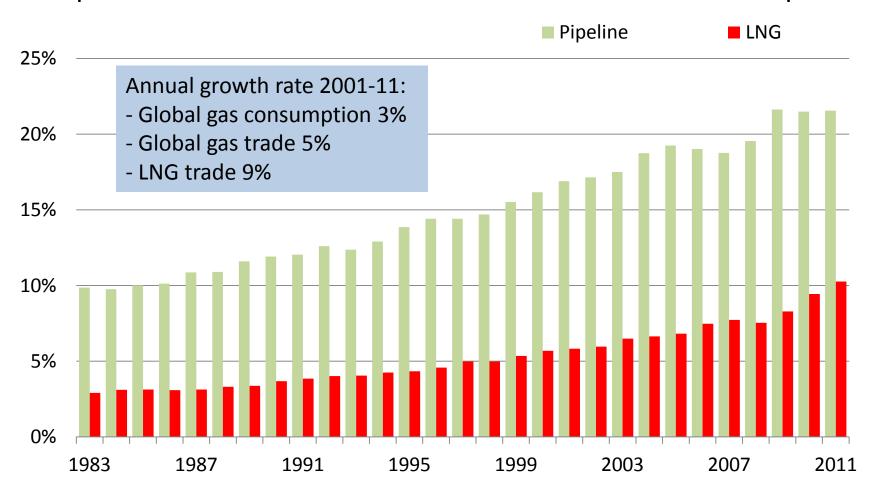
World LNG Estimated November 2012 Landed Prices (\$US/mmbtu)

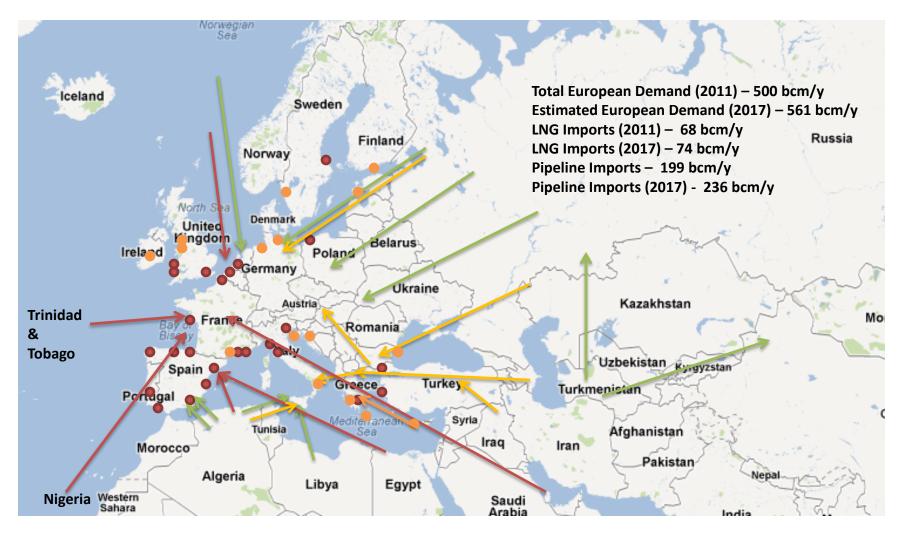
#### Global Gas Trade Rising
