培训内容介绍	1. 主要培训课程介绍 (1) 中国国情：主要介绍中国的政治、经济、社会、文化等发展现状； (2) 中国城镇化进程中城市公共服务发展经验：授课老师会详细介绍中国改革开放 40 年的经验及成果，城市公共服务发展历程、经验成果及政策方向； (3) 中国城市治理能力现代化与城市实践经验：授课老师将与学员共同研讨城市治理的体系及经验模式，分析实际案例，并了解城市治理能力提升与城市可持续发展的相互关系。 (4) 中国基础设施建设与发展情况：授课老师将分析我国城市基础设施建设情况及其对城市可持续发展的重要作用，同时介绍中国新基建的发展情况。 (5) 中国智慧城市创新发展经验介绍：授课老师将介绍中国数字经济发展现状与智慧城市建设优秀案例，并深度分析城市“智理”需要解决的问题及未来发展趋势。 (6) 中国健康城市建设及发展情况：授课老师将结合疫情，介绍中国健康城市的建设发展情况及具体案例，并深度分析健康城市发展中需要解决的问题，及未来发展趋势。		

- (7) 中国金融发展与国际合作经验介绍：授课老师将分析我国金融服务体系、及其对外开展合作的能力，同时介绍新兴城市在金融科技方面的模式创新、特色优势等。
- (8) 中国城市规划与实践经验介绍：授课老师将向学员介绍中国城市规划的实践经验，并系统梳理城市规划、经济布局的有序性，城市空间设计的科学性与延续性如何助力实现城市治理现代化；
- (9) 中国儿童友好城市（社区）建设经验介绍：授课老师将向学员介绍我国儿童友好城市和社区的发展历程及政策方向、并共同探讨城市公共服务如何为儿童成长提供更好的帮助。
- (10) 中国城镇化和城市发展经验介绍：授课老师将向学员介绍中国改革开放 40 余年城镇化进程及城市管理的相关经验，通过案例介绍让学员们了解中国从城市管理到城市治理的进程及其对城市发展的作用。

Enable participants to systematically understand the basic content of the modernization of urban governance capabilities;</p> <p>4. To enable participants to understand the development and process of urban governance in China's 40 years of reform and opening up (concepts, models, roads, programs, etc.), including relevant experience and excellent cases;</p> <p>5. At the end of the course, students can put forward policy suggestions for urban governance and development according to the content of their studies and the national conditions of their own countries</p>

Seminar Content	<p>1. Introduction of main training courses</p> <p>(1) China's national conditions: Mainly introduces China's political, economic, social, cultural and other development status;</p> <p>(2) Development experience of urban public service in the process of Urbanization in China: The teachers will introduce in detail the experience and achievements of China's 40 years of reform and opening up, development history, experience and achievements of urban public service and policy direction;</p> <p>(3) Modernization of Urban governance capacity and urban practical experience in China:</p>		

Teachers and students will discuss urban governance system and experience model, analyze actual cases, and understand the relationship between improvement of urban governance capacity and sustainable urban development.

(4) China's infrastructure construction and development: The teacher will analyze China's urban infrastructure construction and its important role in sustainable urban development, and introduce the development of China's new infrastructure.

(5) **Introduction of Innovative development experience of China's smart city:** The teacher will introduce the development status of China's digital economy and excellent cases of smart city construction, and analyze in depth the problems to be solved in urban "intelligence" and the future development trend.

(6) Construction and development of Healthy cities in China: Teachers will introduce the construction and development of Healthy cities in China and specific cases based on the epidemic situation, and analyze in depth the problems to be solved in the development of healthy cities and the future development trend.

(7) Introduction of China's financial development and international cooperation experience: The teacher will analyze China's financial service system and its ability to carry out cooperation with foreign countries, and introduce the model innovation, characteristics and advantages of emerging cities in fintech.

(8) Introduction of China's urban planning and practical experience: The teacher will introduce the practical experience of China's urban planning to the students, and systematically comb out the order of urban planning and economic layout, and how the scientificity and continuity of urban space design can help realize the modernization of urban governance;

(9) Introduction to the construction experience of China's child-friendly cities (communities) : The teacher will introduce the development process and policy direction of China's child-friendly cities and communities, and discuss how urban public services can provide better help for children's growth.

(10) **Introduction of China's urbanization and urban development Experience:** The teacher will introduce the relevant experience of China's urbanization process and urban management over the past 40 years of reform and opening up to the students. Through case introduction, the students will understand the process from urban management to urban governance in China and its role in urban development.
