The eighth annual **International Conference on Cyber Engagement** (ICCE) will be held on April 23, 2019, in Washington, DC. The International Conference on Cyber Engagement has been organized since 2011 by **Dr. Catherine Lotrionte**, founder of the International Conference on Cyber Engagement and Brent Scowcroft Scholar at the Atlantic Council. This year, it will be hosted for the first time by the Atlantic Council's Scowcroft Center for Strategy and Security, in partnership with Dentons, PKO Bank Polski, and Texas A&M University. The International Conference on Cyber Engagement draws on the experience of government practitioners, industry representatives, and academic scholars to bring a multidisciplinary and global approach to challenges in cyberspace.

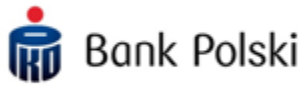
