The United States, along with its allies, has provided critical budget support to Ukraine, ensuring continuity of government and civilian services as Ukrainians try to survive the winter.



# **Categories of Support**



## **PENSIONS**

\$2.5 billion—to cover 9.8 million people's pensions



# **HEALTHCARE**

\$2 billion—to cover critical healthcare services and regular patient care



### **CITIZEN SERVICES**

\$1.3 billion—to cover continuity of government and services to citizens



# SOCIAL ASSISTANCE

\$487 million—to cover social assistance to 240,000 low-income families and 480,000 people with disabilities



#### FIRST RESPONDERS

\$472 million—to cover salaries of first responders



# **IDP ASSISTANCE**

\$406 million—to cover assistance to 1.3 million internally displaced people



# **EDUCATION SALARIES**

\$385 million—to cover salaries for 618,000 school and university workers



## **HOUSING SUBSIDIES**

\$281 million—to cover housing subsidies to 1.6 million households



#### PENDING DISBURSEMENT

\$669 million—still pending
